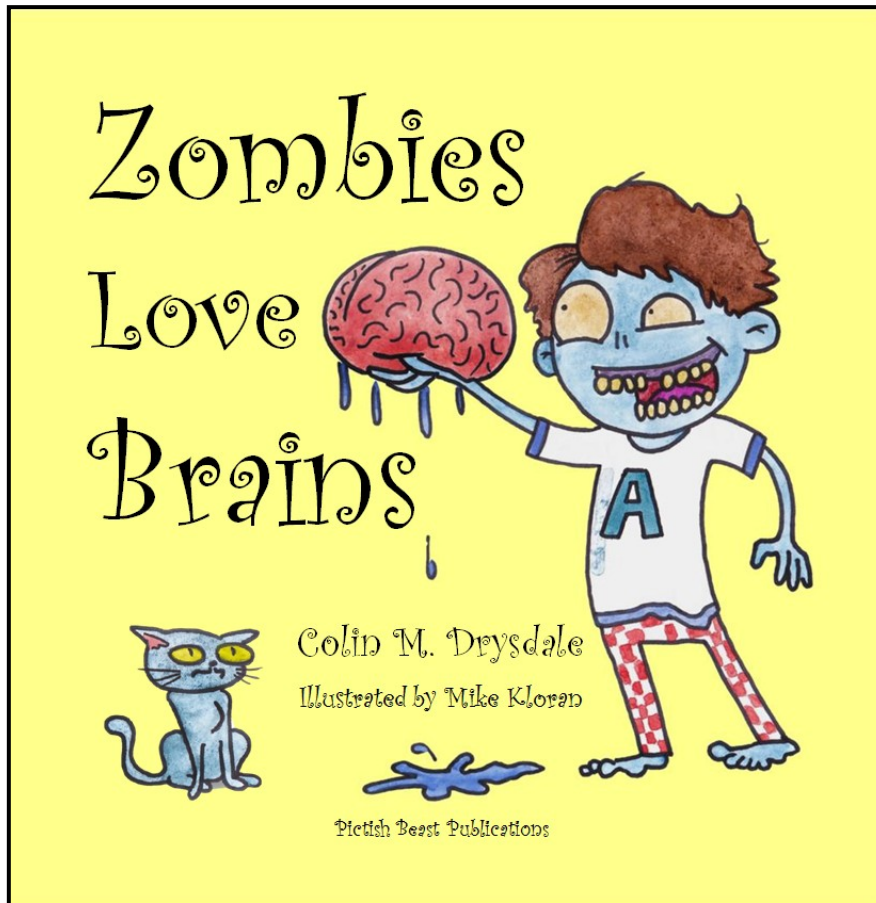


# Zombies Love Brains
